

Connected and Respectful Tasmania Grant - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)



The guidelines say my activity needs to be inclusive – does that mean I have to invite everyone?

Activities which the assessment panel deem to be exclusionary or discriminatory will not be considered. Activities may, however, be centred around a particular interest or cultural group.

I don't have a Working with Vulnerable People Card – can I still apply?

You can still run an event or activity as long as children are accompanied by their parents, guardians or caregivers, and as long as there will not be time where children will be alone with adults who do not have a WWVP card. We reserve the right to reject applications we deem to be of risk to children or other vulnerable people.

I don't have an ABN – can I still apply?

Yes, you can, but you may be required to submit a Statement by Supplier or provide us with additional information by request. We reserve the right to deny an application if appropriate risk controls cannot be met.

Can I have alcohol at my activity/event, as long as I don't sell it?

No, these grants are only available for drug and alcohol free events. Whether alcohol is provided for free, at a cost, or provided by attendees/participants of your activity is not relevant.

Do I need to provide insurance documents as part of my application?

No. Relationships Australia Tasmania does not assume any risk through the provision of these grants, and so we do not require evidence of your insurance. It is each recipient's responsibility to undertake appropriate risk assessments and risk mitigation, including but not limited to relevant insurances, licenses, permits etc.



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Do I need to get permits or other permissions for my activity or event?

It is your responsibility to find out whether permits or other permissions are required for your activity or event, and we trust that if you are making an application that you have any approvals required, or can get them within the required timeframes. If you apply without approvals, and your activity/event cannot proceed due to lack of permissions, you will be required to refund any payments made to you for reallocation to another applicant.

When do the grants open and close?

Grants open 14 October 2026, and close 5pm 1 December 2026.
